- I. Call to Order

 - A. Ms. Victoria Brundza, Hollywood Hills Student Government President and Ms. Ida Butler, Hollywood Hills Student Government Advisor both welcomed BCASC and said Hollywood Hills is happy to host a general meeting.
 - B. Mr. Daniel Most, Hollywood Hills HS Principal, recognized the work of BCASC and student leaders across the county and creating meaningful impact across the district. - B. Middle School Vice President's Report
 1. BCASC Middle School Vice President Landyn Spellberg reported that the end of the year video is being developed and that the Microsoft Form accepting videos is available. - IX. Student Advisors to the School Board Report
 - A. Student Advisor to the School Board Raymond Adderly reported that the Student Advisor election applications are now open and are due by February 11th, 2022. Mr. Adderly also urged students to understand the importance of seeing something and saying something to ensure the security and well-being of all students at all schools. Additionally, Mr. Adderly reported that a social media focus group in collaboration with the school board will meet and discuss how to post responsibly. Finally, Mr. Adderly explained that "Rally to Tally" is a district sponsored field trip for two high school representatives who are all split into county districts, and for those attending, the last preparation meeting occurred on January 13th, 2022.
