VI. Guest Speakers

- A. Ms. Renee Herman, Harvest Drive Founder, and Ms. Amy Freund, Harvest Drive Program Coordinator, spoke on the importance of leadership contributing to those struggling within our community. - B. Mr. Angel Gomez, Coordinator, Community Outreach, Legislative Affairs, Mr. Michael Walker, Director, School Climate & Discipline, and Ms. Kimberly Young, Liaison/Coordinator, School Climate & Discipline, spoke about the new social media trends affecting schools across the nation. Caused by a loss in routine and an excess of freedom at home from virtual school, students are vandalizing schools through 'devious licks'. Therefore, to create positive messages and counter the negativity around these trends, BCPS enacted 'Angelic Yields' and a week of #schoolprideandpeace to raise awareness on these issues and change the negative mentality within schools. Therefore, to create a peaceful learning environment, county officials on behalf of the School Board and the Superintendent tasked BCASC and student leaders to work together to create pride and peace across the county and amplify students' concerns. On November 3rd, the Superintendent will host a 'Meet & Chat' where students can directly state their concerns on the current educational climate.
